

Eligibility for Undergraduate Exchange Programme

1. Students must have proficiency in English.
2. Student must have successfully completed at least one year of education with good academic standing within a relevant field of study at their home institution.



Application for Exchange Programme

Exchange partners nominate their selected students via email.

All nominated students will receive an acceptance email/letter with the application instructions and practical information about the exchange programme at LUMS. Students may complete the application form and send it back via email and courier along with the required documents as follows:
