Provides students with a set of balanced curricula that include both international cultures and languages. It's a series of culture-related courses that are exclusively taught in English.

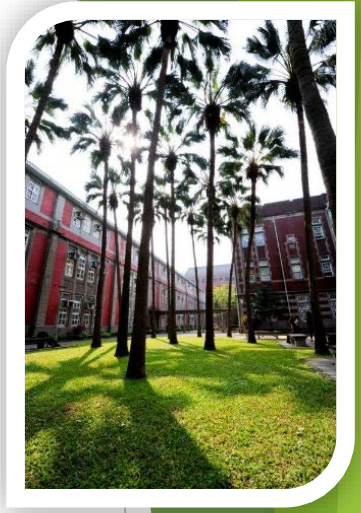

### Visa Requirements

- **For One-Semester Exchange Student**  
Study **LESS** than 6 months: **VISITOR VISA**; then apply for extension within 15 days before the duration expired.
- **For One-Academic-Year Exchange Student**  
Study **MORE** than 6 months: **RESIDENT VISA**; then apply for Alien Resident Certificates (ARC) within 15 days after arrival.

All exchange students are required to purchase both overseas **Accidental Insurance** & overseas **Medical Insurance**. Each kind of insurance shall worth a minimum of NT\$1,000,000 (approx. US\$35,000\*) valid for the entire exchange period.  
From the 7th month of the stay, students are required to join **National Health Insurance (NHI)** of Taiwan according to the laws.

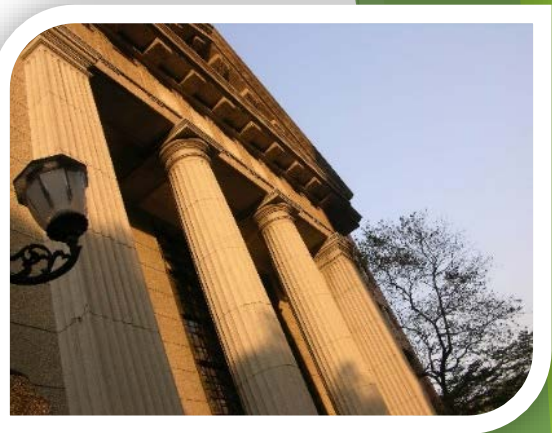

- Have completed at least 1 year of university work prior to participation in exchange

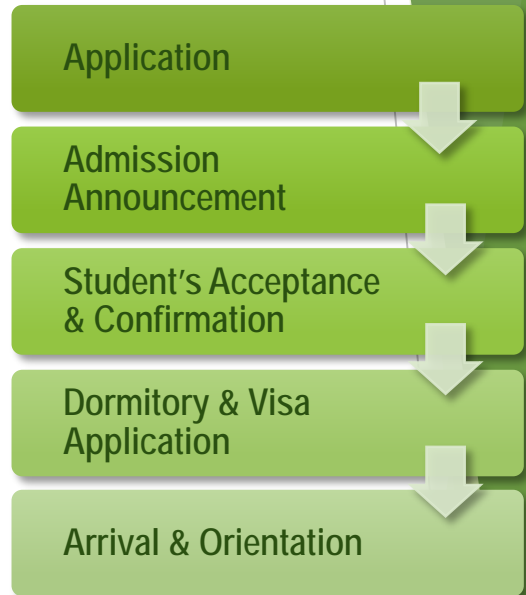
