  - o Strengthen the foundation of Korean Studies through the collection of fundamental Korean Studies materials and the establishment of related databases.

However, an individual may serve as project director for only two projects. (In the case of participation in more than one project, overlapping payment of labor expenses is strictly prohibited.)
  - O However, the following are not to be counted: 1) projects which end within six months from the application deadline, and 2) certain specially designated projects (as listed in the Korean Application Guidelines).
- Persons who are under research sanctions as of the application deadline may be restricted from applying.
