Incoming Exchange Students

Nominee from Partner University (Tuition Fee Waiver)

Students who are currently enrolled in one of our partner universities, and were nominated to study at NSYSU for one semester or one academic year based on the bilateral agreement between the two institutions. The nominee will only need to pay tuition fees at their home universities.

Fee-paying Student (Free-mover)

Students who are currently enrolled in an overseas university and applying to study at NSYSU for one semester or one academic year by themselves. A fee-paying student should pay the tuition fees to both their home university and NSYSU.

Water sports courses: yachting, windsurfing, diving, etc.


Course Regulations for Exchange Students:

- Minimum credits to obtain: 3; Maximum credits to obtain: 25
- Exchange students can choose courses from different departments/institutes, colleges, and study levels.
- Part of the courses is only open to students who meet the course-taking requirements. Students who cannot meet the requirements can ask for the lecturers' approval to register for the courses under Exceptional Circumstances.

Visa

All students must apply for a visa to enter Taiwan.

One-semester Student

One-semester students are required to apply for a **Visitor Visa** to enter Taiwan and extend their visa 15 days before the 60/90 days of Duration of Stay expires.

One-year Student

For students staying for a full academic year, they must obtain a **Resident Visa** to enter Taiwan, and they are required to apply for an **Alien Resident**Certificate (ARC) within 15 days counting from the next day of their arrival.

Students are suggested to contact the Taiwan consulate in their country/region for the most up-to-date information.

Please do not make any financial commitments, travel, or accommodation plans before receiving a visa.

Students should purchase flexible flight tickets in case of any changes to their flights.

Insurance & Health Certificate

Insurance

Students are required to purchase overseas travel insurance with medical and accident policies that cover the whole duration of their stay in Taiwan. The insurance plan in English or Chinese version must be submitted on the university's registration day.

Students are also required to purchase the NSYSU Student Group Insurance (326NTD/semester).

One-year students who hold an ARC for more than 6 months are eligible to apply for the NHI (National Health Insurance). They need to contact the OIA coordinator once they are eligible to apply for an NHI card.

Health Examination

All exchange students are required to complete health examinations before coming to Taiwan.

One-semester students: <u>Health Certificate Form C</u>

One-year students: <u>Health Certificate Form B</u>

A copy of the medical form must be submitted upon registration.





Course Selection Phases

There are 5 course selection phases for exchange students to choose courses. The first online course selection period will start two weeks before class begins.

- (1) Preliminary Course Selection II.
- (2) Add & Drop I.
- (3) Add & Drop II,
- (4) Exceptional Circumstances
- (5) Withdrawal

Credit and Grading System

Every 18 hours is counted as 1 credit. If the total class hour during a semester is 54 hours, the course will be a 3-credit course.

1 Credit = 2 FCTS

Areas of Study Open to Exchange Students

All fields are open to exchange students as long as the student has adequate Chinese proficiency. Otherwise, students can only take courses offered in English.

Students are allowed to choose courses from different departments/colleges and levels.

Some master-level courses are only open to exchange students in a later selection phase.
