Who can participate?

- Participants must meet the following eligibility.
- (1) An applicant demonstrating excellent academic and personal records at their home university.
- (2) An applicant must be an officially registered full-time student of his/her home institution.
- (3) An applicant should have a definite motivation as well as a clear study plan in any field available at their host universities and likely to benefit from studying in Japan.
- (4) An applicant must be a citizen of a country that has diplomatic relations with Japan. JSPS treats Taiwanese and Palestinian students in this manner. Students who are Japanese citizen and foreigners who are permitted permanent residence in Japan are not eligible.
- (5) An applicant must have a Grade Point Average of 2.3 (on a 3.0 scale) or higher in the academic year preceding the scholarship application based on the GPA calculation set by JASSO. Grades subject to evaluation for this scholarship period are those awarded in the previous fiscal year. Detailed instructions on the GPA calculation are provided on the Application form.
- (6) An applicant not having sufficient financial means to study in Japan.
- (7) If an applicant is scheduled to receive another scholarship in addition to the JASSO

scholarship while studying in Japan, the amount of the other scholarship must not be more than 80,000 yen.

- (8) An applicant must return to his /her home institution to complete his/her degree program there or be awarded a degree from his/her home institution upon completion of his/her study at Chiba University.
- (9) An applicant must be able to submit Application form (ID Photo attached), GPA Calculator sheet, and CV by May 6.
- (10) An applicant must be able to submit the information of flight and hotel he/she booked and passport photo by June 15.
